

## Letter from Founder and President, Jimmy Wilson

Two days after Christmas, my phone buzzed unexpectedly at 3:30 a.m. I hoped it was a wrong number. No such luck. There was a fire at Bay Wood. Dozens of first responders were working to extinguish a blaze in an area where wooden pallets are treated with heat.

We were blessed. No one was injured. While several pieces of equipment sustained damage, our crews never missed a beat. Our company also never missed a day making wooden pallets and custom crates for customers.

As I write this in mid-January, we are working with another plant to heat-treat some of our pallets so there is no interruption of deliveries. We also purchased a larger-capacity kiln before the New Year. Plans call for our new unit to be up and running by March 2018.





My nature is to take something like this and turn it into a positive. While an inspector hasn't determined an exact cause of the fire, we asked him to share best practices that can be added to our safety protocols already in place. He was glad to do so. Now, we are updating the processes on how wood is treated to further ensure the safety of our team and the most efficient use of resources.
